Adoption and Implementation

During Back to School Night each year, all parents are given the opportunity to volunteer to be a part of the Parent/Guardian Title Committee. All Title I teachers inform their students' parents that this committee will meet to review the Family Engagement Policy and adjust the policy as needed throughout the school year. Parents/Stakeholders will be presented with the Family Engagement Policy during the Title I Back to School Night. All parents will be able to give their input to ensure that our school's Family Engagement Policy is as effective as possible.

Meetings

Meetings will occur on a continual basis throughout the school year. Meetings will be scheduled at various times to accommodate the schedules of all members. An annual meeting will be held within the first quarter of the school year. At this meeting:

- Parents will be informed of our school's participation as a Title I school.
- The rights and requirements for parents to be involved will be explained.
 All Title I Documents will be shared and reviewed

These meetings will provide all parents of Title I students with an opportunity to plan, review, and offer suggestions to improve the Title I program, including the Parent and Family Engagement Policy. Parents will be encouraged to request a meeting if needed to further engage the school in the continued development of the Title I program and continued student achievement of their child.

Distribution of Information

Parent Centers are located in the main foyer of our school. Information about the Title I program is posted on our CA School Website. Hard copies of information are made available at our Title I events.

Funding

Our Title II and Title IV funds will be consolidated into the Title I funding account. These funds are allocated to support the school's academic priorities, enhance parent engagement initiatives, and address technology needs for both instructional and family engagement purposes.

Distribution of Information

Our school will send home information in each family's home language when applicable to inform parents of what is happening in our Title I program. Opportunities to volunteer and be part of the process will be sent home to parents. Parents will be encouraged to participate and be involved. Meetings will be scheduled at different times to ensure that all parents have the opportunity to be involved in the process. Title information is posted on our District website and REMIND social media is used to communicate meetings.
