School Social Worker

The Carbondale Area School District is seeking applicants for the position of School Social Worker.

Purpose: To support students in overcoming personal, emotional, and social challenges that may impact their ability to adjust to the school environment and fully benefit from their educational experience.

Responsibilities: The School Social Worker conducts assessments to understand students' functioning and the impact of home, school, and community environments. They develop and implement intervention plans, provide individual and group counseling, and support students during crises. They also offer parent and caregiver training, connect families to community resources, and collaborate with school staff and outside agencies to support student well-being, mental health, safety, and academic success. Additionally, they help foster a positive school climate and facilitate access to external support services through interagency partnerships.

Qualifications:

1. As established by state certification laws and regulations
2. Act 34 Clearance, Act 151 Clearance, Act 114 Clearance, TB Test
3. Licensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a School Social Worker, Licensed Social Worker, or a Licensed/Clinical Social Worker and be eligible for an emergency certificate by enrolling in a PDE approved School Social Worker Program.
4. Possess an undergraduate degree in education, social work, or related field
5. Have knowledge of community mental health agencies
6. Have experience with students exhibiting behavioral and emotional concerns
7. Have experience working in a human services field or counseling, preferably in a public-school setting
8. Demonstrate an understanding of Special Education processes and procedures
9. Three (3) Letters of Reference
